

Positive and Negative Feedback loop posters

Background: In our study of homeostasis, we have been learning about the characteristics of life and specifically the processes necessary for maintaining a stable internal environment. For this assignment, you will create a poster that represents an example of a positive feedback loop and an example of a negative feedback loop.

Listed below are the items needed on your poster to obtain full credit:

- Remember – posters grab attention and are usually very “eyecatching.” Ex.) Use color, be neat – use rulers when necessary, make your poster balanced
- layout...spelling also counts!
Divide the space in half, devoting one side to explanation of the feedback type and a diagram example of the type of feedback.
- Define positive feedback and negative feedback, and on the appropriate side of the poster. Write these definitions prominently and clearly.
- Include a labeled diagram on each half of the poster showing an example of the type of feedback.
- Each example diagram should include at least four distinct steps and include illustrations in addition to text and arrows showing the flow of the loop.
- Make the title large and legible “Feedback Loops”
- Write your name, date and period on the back of the poster.
